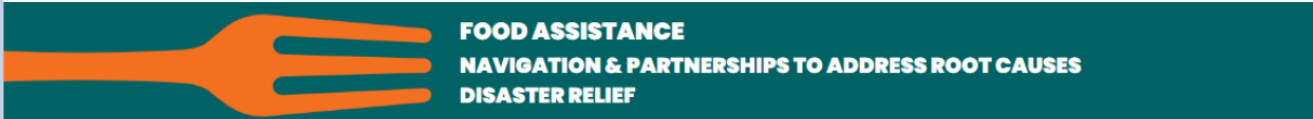
Target Hunger is a 501c3 non-profit agency whose mission is to **alleviate hunger and its root causes** in the Houston neighborhoods we serve. *Our vision is a Houston where no one goes hungry and everyone can provide food for themselves and their families.*

Your support of our 2025 *Garden Gala* ensures Target Hunger can sustain operations to provide help and hope to our Houston neighbors in need!

WHO DO WE SERVE? We provide fresh and nutritious food assistance to low-income children, families, and seniors battling food insecurity.

WHERE DO WE SERVE? Target Hunger's services are focused on some of the most underserved neighborhoods in Houston. Established in 1989 to serve the Fifth Ward and Kashmere Gardens, our primary service area has since expanded to include northeast and east Houston. Last year, individuals came from over 200 zip codes.

HOW DO WE SERVE?



FOOD ASSISTANCE ensures families receive nutritious food.

- **Monthly Groceries** provided through fixed-site and mobile choice pantries, community partner locations, and home deliveries for seniors and individuals with disabilities, include fresh produce, protein, and shelf-stable items.
- **Food Fairs**, hosted twice a week in food deserts, offer healthy, fresh, seasonal produce to anyone in need.
- **Summer Youth Breakfast & Lunch Program** provides distribution to children when school is out of session.



NAVIGATION & PARTNERSHIPS TO ADDRESS ROOT CAUSES

help the community combat the cycle of poverty that creates chronic food insecurity.

- The **Navigation Program** connects individuals to vital resources within our community. Our trained Navigators, all certified as Texas State Community Health Workers, serve as key liaisons. Referrals include rental and utility assistance, job training, financial literacy, continuing education, healthcare enrollment, and more.
- **Community Gardens** produce thousands of pounds of nutritious vegetables that are distributed to clients. One is located in Kashmere Gardens and the other at our Shotwell Campus.



DISASTER RELIEF delivers help when needed most.

- **Disaster Distributions** aid families after natural disasters, while **Emergency Food** supports families facing personal crises throughout the year.
