FOOD ASSISTANCE ensures families receive nutritious food.

- **Monthly Groceries** provided through fixed-site and mobile choice pantries, community partner locations, and home deliveries for seniors and individuals with disabilities, include fresh produce, protein, and shelf-stable items.
- **Food Fairs**, hosted twice a week in food deserts, offer healthy, fresh, seasonal produce to anyone in need.
- **Summer Youth Breakfast & Lunch Program** provides distribution to children when school is out of session.

NAVIGATION & PARTNERSHIPS TO ADDRESS ROOT CAUSES

help the community combat the cycle of poverty that creates chronic food insecurity.

- The *Navigation Program* connects individuals to vital resources within our community. Our trained Navigators, all certified as Texas State Community Health Workers, serve as key liaisons. Referrals include rental and utility assistance, job training, financial literacy, continuing education, healthcare enrollment, and more.
- **Community Gardens** produce thousands of pounds of nutritious vegetables that are distributed to clients. One is located in Kashmere Gardens and the other at our Shotwell Campus.
